CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine ("Committee of the Joint Boards") and David Mark Mercer, L.N.P., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Mercer's license to practice as a nurse practitioner in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. David Mark Mercer, L.N.P., was issued License Number 0024-167069 to practice as a nurse practitioner on August 18, 2006, which is scheduled to expire on April 30, 2017. Mr. Mercer was also issued Prescriptive Authority Number 0017-139039 on December 4, 2007, which is scheduled to expire on April 30, 2017.
- 2. During the course of his employment with the University of Virginia Health System, Charlottesville, Virginia:
- a. Mr. Mercer violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(2) and (5), 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(m) and (p) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing (currently found at 18 VAC 90-19-230(2)(m) and (p) effective February 24, 2017) and 18 VAC 90-30-220(4) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners in that from March 14, 2016 to April 6, 2016, he disclosed protected health information of numerous patients to a sales representative of a pharmaceutical company.

- b. Mr. Mercer violated Virginia Code §§ 54.1-3007(5), 54.1-3302 and 54.1-3420.2(B) and 18 VAC 90-30-220(4) and (6) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners in that:
- i) In February 2016, Mr. Mercer ordered sample tubes of Regranex Gel (becaplermin, C-VI) directly from a vendor's sales representative and had the samples delivered to his home address, without a pharmacy license, permit or registration and without the knowledge or authorization of the medical center's pharmacy department. Further, Mr. Mercer stored the samples in an uncontrolled environment in his home refrigerator and in the employee refrigerator at work.
- ii) On April 4, 2016, Mr. Mercer ordered a three-month supply of Collagenase SANTYL ointment (C-VI) directly from a vendor's sales representative without a pharmacy license, permit or registration and without informing the medical center's pharmacy department.
- c. Mr. Mercer violated Virginia Code §§ 54.1-3007(5) and 18 VAC 90-30-220(4) of the Regulations Governing the Licensure of Nurse Practitioners in that on four occasions from March 4, 2016 to March 15, 2016, Mr. Mercer documented administering Regranex (becaplermin, C-VI) to a patient in the outpatient clinic; however, he failed to document an order in the patient's medical records to include the medication name, strength, dosage amount, frequency and duration. On March 8, 2016, Mr. Mercer documented that a family member would continue with the Regranex; however, he failed to document that the patient was supplied a sample and any prescribing information.

CONSENT

David Mark Mercer, L.N.P., by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

- 1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Committee of the Joint Boards; and the right to representation by counsel;
 - 4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Committee of the Joint Boards is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my licensure to practice as a nurse practitioner in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Committee of the Joint Boards hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. David Mark Mercer, L.N.P., is REPRIMANDED.
- 2. David Mark Mercer, L.N.P., shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of nurse practitioners in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
