**JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

The Virginia Committee of the Joint Boards of Nursing and Medicine (“Committee of the Joint Boards”) adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues this Order affecting the license of Amanda M. Moore, L.N.P., to practice as a licensed nurse practitioner.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On July 31, 2012, the Committee of the Joint Boards issued License Number 0024-170245 to Amanda M. Moore, L.N.P., to practice as a nurse practitioner in the Commonwealth of Virginia and Prescriptive Authority Number 0017-140593. Said license is scheduled to expire on November 30, 2018. The prescriptive authority is also scheduled to expire on November 30, 2018.
2. By Order of the Committee of the Joint Boards entered on October 29, 2015, Ms. Moore was placed on probation for a period of 12 months of actual nurse practitioner practice, with terms and conditions, due to findings involving the prescribing of controlled substances to patients with pain management issues.
3. Ms. Moore submitted a petition for release from probation which was received by the Board of Nursing on September 19, 2016.
4. Ms. Moore has complied with all terms and conditions of probation.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


1. This matter is properly before the Committee of the Joint Boards.
2. Amanda M. Moore, L.N.P., has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation.

**ORDER**


It is ORDERED that the terms and conditions placed on the license of Amanda M. Moore, L.N.P., to practice as a nurse practitioner in the Commonwealth of Virginia are TERMINATED and Ms. Moore shall be issued an unrestricted license.
