Dear Ms. Davis:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered July 19, 2011. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director for the Board of Nursing at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

The presentence report was considered and filed as part of the record in accordance with the provisions of Code §19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01 the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets were reviewed and considered by the Court and are ordered filed as part of the record.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration in the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: FOUR (4) YEARS on each charge of Child Neglect (2 counts). The terms shall run concurrently. The total sentence imposed is FOUR (4) YEARS.

The Court SUSPENDS ALL of the sentence on the following conditions:

- 1. Good Behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for four (4) years.
- 2. Supervised Probation. The defendant is placed on supervised probation. The defendant shall be on probation until released by the probation officer. Probation under the supervision of a probation officer shall commence upon sentencing unless the defendant is remanded to custody at sentencing then it shall commence upon release from incarceration. The defendant shall comply with all the rules, terms and requirements set by the probation officer. The defendant shall undergo and complete substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment directed by the probation officer.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs pursuant to § 19.2-354.
