ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues this Order affecting the license of Janie Herring-Long, R.N., to practice as a professional nurse in Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Janie Herring-Long, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-116575 to practice as a professional nurse by the Virginia Board of Nursing on September 28, 1989. Said license expired on January 31, 2003, was reinstated on November 12, 2014, and currently expires on January 31, 2017. Ms. Herring-Long also holds License No. RN50722 to practice professional nursing in the District of Columbia. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. By Order of the Board entered on November 12, 2014, the Board reinstated Ms. Herring-Long's license contingent upon her continued compliance with all terms and conditions of the District of Columbia Board of Nursing Committee on Impaired Nurses ("COIN").
 - 3. Ms. Herring-Long successfully completed the COIN program on January 15, 2016.
 - 4. Ms. Herring-Long submitted a petition for release from probation on June 5, 2015.
- 5. Ms. Herring-Long has complied with all terms and conditions of the Order of the Board entered on November 12, 2014.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This matter is properly before the Board.

2. Janie Herring-Long, R.N., has demonstrated satisfactory evidence to warrant release from probation.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the petition of Janie Herring-Long, R.N., for release from probation is hereby GRANTED and Ms. Herring-Long shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice as a professional nurse.

Ms. Herring-Long shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
