Dear Ms. Sikes:

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, you are hereby given notice that your license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered November 16, 2016. You are hereby advised that you may not practice professional nursing or hold yourself out as a licensed professional nurse unless and until the Board of Nursing has notified you in writing that your license has been reinstated. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board"), at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

You may apply to the Board for reinstatement of your license, and you shall be entitled to a formal administrative hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of 60 days from the Board's receipt of your reinstatement application. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board present at the hearing. The reinstatement application can be found at www.dhp.virginia.gov/Nursing.

ORDER OF MANDATORY SUSPENSION


In accordance with Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Jennifer Kate Sikes, R.N., was convicted of a felony offense, to wit: one count of grand larceny. A certified copy of the Corrected Sentencing Order is attached hereto as Commonwealth's Exhibit 1.

WHEREUPON, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Jennifer Kate Sikes, R.N., to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Jennifer Kate Sikes, R.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current and valid. Should Jennifer Kate Sikes, R.N., seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of the license prior to issuance of the license to resume practice.

This Order shall be applicable to Ms. Sikes' multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-4023 and § 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

CORRECTED SENTENCING ORDER

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF HENRICO COUNTY

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

vs.

JENNIFER KATE SIKES

On July 24, 2012, came the defendant, who appeared according to the conditions of her bond, and came also J. Bradley Davis, her attorney. Thomas Johnson represented the Commonwealth.

On April 24, 2012, the defendant was found guilty of the following offense:

The pre-sentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code Section 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheet. The sentencing guidelines worksheet and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

And it being demanded of the defendant if anything for herself she had or knew to say why judgment should not be pronounced against her according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, the Court sentences the defendant to incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for a term of two (2) years and twelve (12) months, the execution of two (2) years and eleven (11) months of which sentence is suspended for five (5) years. Conditions of the suspended sentence are that she keep the peace and be of good behavior, that she abstain from the use of alcohol and illegal drugs, that she is barred from contact with the victim Senna H. Birmingham, that upon her release from incarceration she report to be placed on probation under the supervision of a District 32 Probation Officer of this Court, and that she pay \$1,000.00 restitution to Senna H. Birmingham, plus any monitoring fees through the Henrico Community Corrections Program within six (6) months of her release from incarceration. The Court orders that the balance of the sentence ordered to serve shall be suspended upon her transfer to the Chesterfield Women's Diversion Program.

The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code Section 53.1-187.

The Court orders that the defendant pay the costs of this case in the amount of \$450.00.



By operation of law, the defendant's privilege to operate a motor vehicle shall be suspended by the Department of Motor Vehicles effective thirty days from this date if costs are not paid pursuant to Virginia Code Section 46.2-395.

The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the defendant was present in person and her attorney was likewise present in person and capably represented the defendant.

Thereupon, the defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff, to be held until she can be transferred to the Chesterfield Women's Diversion Program.
