<u>ORDER</u>

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021, and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a Special Conference Committee ("Committee") of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") met on April 3, 2008, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon Maria Rodgers' application for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, and to consider evidence that Ms. Rodgers may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nurse aide practice in Virginia. Ms. Rodgers was not present and was not represented by counsel.

Upon consideration of the evidence, the Committee adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.


FINDINGS OF FACT

- Maria Rodgers was issued Certificate No. 1401-003192 to practice as a nurse aide in the
 Commonwealth of Virginia on February 23, 1989. Said certificate expired on February 28, 2007.
- 2. Ms. Rodgers submitted an application for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide, which was received by the Board on August 1, 2007.
- 3. Ms. Rodgers was convicted of one felony count of possession of cocaine with intent to distribute in the Circuit Court of Danville, Virginia, on July 27, 2006, and was sentenced to six years incarceration (with all but nine months suspended); supervised probation for two years; substance abuse screening; and costs.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 3 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code.
