You may apply to the Board for reinstatement of your license, and you shall be entitled to a formal administrative hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of 60 days from the Board's receipt of your reinstatement application. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board present at the hearing. This case came before the Court for trial of the defendant, who appeared in person with her attorney, Holly Ortiz. The Commonwealth was represented by Mary Button.

The defendant stands charged with the following offense(s):

Whereupon the defendant waived arraignment and the Court having been advised by the defendant, her counsel and the attorney for the Commonwealth that there has been a **PLEA AGREEMENT** in this case, and such agreement in writing having been presented to the Court, and now filed herein, and having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, the Court accepts said agreement and the plea of **guilty** to **Credit Card Theft as charged in Indictment #1**, that the defendant tendered in person and finds the defendant guilty of same.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to:
Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 5 years for Credit Card Theft as charged in Indictment #1.
The total sentence imposed is 5 years.

This sentence shall run consecutively with all other sentences.

The Court SUSPENDS 5 years of Indictment #1 sentence, for a period of 5 years, for a total suspension of 5 years, upon the following condition(s): The Court orders the defendant shall complete 150 hours of community Service within 1 year, pay the amount of \$86.76 in restitution within 6 months and shall have no contact with the victim, Brandi Carr.

Uniform good behavior. The defendant shall be of uniform good behavior while in custody and for 5 years after release from all confinement.

Fines/Costs/Restitution. The following amounts are due and payable at the time of sentencing. If the total payment is not made on the date of sentencing, the defendant shall enter into an Installment Agreement Plan with the Circuit Court Clerk's Office and a judgment entered therein. All payments are to be made payable to the Clerk, Norfolk Circuit Court. Payments shall be made no less than the minimum rate of \$50.00 per month beginning on the first day of the first month following conviction or beginning within 90 days of the release from incarceration.

Costs: \$488.24
Restitution: \$86.76
TOTAL: \$575.89

Credit for time served. The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code Section 53.1-187.

Notice of Destruction of Exhibits. The Clerk hereby gives notice to the defendant and the attorney for the Commonwealth that any and all exhibits introduced in this matter may be destroyed pursuant to Virginia Code Section 19.2-270.4.

The Court, by motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth, Orders a Nolle Prosequi be entered with regard to Credit Card Forgery as charged in Indictment #2, and the defendant discharged thereon.
