2. The application of Ms. Foster for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP

examination, Ms. Foster shall be issued an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the

Commonwealth.
