NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Alexandria Blackmon, R.N., who, prior to its mandatory suspension by the Department of Health Professions on January 30, 2013, held License No. 0001-240305, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on July 16, 2013, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Blackmon will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Blackmon has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Blackmon desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive and act upon Ms. Blackmon’s application for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Blackmon may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.


The burden rests upon Ms. Blackmon, as the applicant, to demonstrate that she is capable of resuming the safe and competent practice of nursing in Virginia.

Pursuant to § 54.1-2409 of the Code, reinstatement of Ms. Blackmon's license requires the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board in attendance at the hearing.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Ms. Blackmon may have violated § 54.1-3007(7) of the Code in that on or about January 14, 2013, the Minnesota Board of Nursing suspended her license to practice professional nursing based on findings that she owed \$500.00 or more in delinquent taxes to the State of Minnesota.
