2. The application of Ms. Elliott for licensure to practice practical nursing in the

Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-PN

examination, Ms. Elliott shall be issued an unrestricted license to practice practical nursing in the

Commonwealth.

Ms. Elliott shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of practical 3.

nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall

remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made

available for public inspection and copying upon request.
