Pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, you are hereby given notice that your license to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered October 3, 2016. You may apply to the Board for reinstatement of your license, and you shall be entitled to a formal administrative hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of 60 days from the Board's receipt of your reinstatement application. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board present at the hearing. CHAUNCEY RAY SAVAGE, DEFENDANT

This day came the defendant, who stands indicted for a felony, to-wit: Grand Larceny, which occurred on or about August 29, 2015, and who appeared in Court according to the condition of his recognizance; and also came his retained attorney, Anthony F. Anderson. The Commonwealth was represented by Joshua T. Dietz, Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney.

Whereupon the defendant, after private consultation with his counsel, stated that he was ready for trial and desired and consented to be tried on this day. The Attorney for the Commonwealth also consented. Thereupon the defendant was duly arraigned and after being advised by his counsel pleaded Nolo Contendere to the indictment, which plea was tendered by the defendant in person, and the Court having made inquiry found that the defendant fully understood the nature and effect of his plea of Nolo Contendere and of the penalties that may be imposed upon his conviction and of the waiver of trial by jury and of appeal, and proceeded to hear and determine the case without the intervention of a jury as provided by law.

Whereupon the Court having been advised by the defendant, by his counsel, and the Attorney for the Commonwealth that there has been a plea agreement in this case, said plea

agreement having been presented to the Court in writing, and filed herein, and having heard a summary of the evidence from the Attorney for the Commonwealth, said agreement and the plea of Nolo Contendere of the defendant are accepted and the Court finds the defendant guilty of the following offense(s):

The parties, with the concurrence of the Court, waived presentence report.

Pursuant to the provisions of Virginia Code §19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are Ordered filed as a part of the record in this case and are open for inspection.

The Court heard and considered any evidence offered and the argument of counsel.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court SENTENCES the defendant to: Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of two years. This sentence shall run consecutive to all other sentences.

The Court SUSPENDS two years after serving thirty days in jail, upon the following conditions:

This sentence will be served on consecutive "modified" weekends from 8:00 a.m. on Monday until 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, beginning on May 23, 2016, and execution of sentence is SUSPENDED until that day at that time.

The defendant, in order to continue serving his sentence on "modified" weekends, must

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comply with the Roanoke City Jail's rules for weekend sentences. It is a condition of the suspended sentences that the defendant report, and do so on time and as scheduled, to serve the active sentence imposed herein.

Supervised probation. The defendant shall be on probation under the supervision of a Probation Officer of this Court, for a period of one year commencing on May 2, 2016, subject to further Order of the Court. The defendant shall: (1) keep the peace, be of good behavior and obey the law; (2) pay the restitution and court costs as set forth herein; and (3) abide by all the rules and regulations imposed by his Probation Officer. The defendant shall report to the Probation Office by noon on April 22, 2016 for intake.

Costs. The defendant shall pay the costs of \$488.00 within his one year probationary period.

Restitution. The defendant shall make restitution through the Clerk's Office of this Court as follows: \$811.43 to Sam's Club, 1455 Towne Square Blvd., NW, Roanoke, Virginia 24012, which is due within his probationary period.

Public Works Projects. The Court hereby authorizes the defendant who has been committed to jail to work on public works projects under Virginia Code §53.1-129.

Credit for time served. The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code §53.1-187.

Sample for DNA analysis. A sample of the defendant's blood, saliva or tissue shall be taken for DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid) analysis to determine identification characteristics specific to the person. This sample shall be taken and used only in conformity with the provision of Virginia Code §§19.2-310.2, et seq.

The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the defendant was personally present and his attorney was likewise personally present and capably represented the defendant.

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And the defendant is allowed to depart.
