CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Olivia Christine Divers, C.N.A., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Divers's application for the reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Olivia Christine Divers, C.N.A. was issued Certificate Number 1401-160749 to practice as a nurse aide on June 12, 2013, which expired on June 30, 2015.
- 2. Olivia Christine Divers submitted an application to reinstate her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia on June 7, 2016.
- 3. Ms. Divers violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(4) in that on April 13, 2015, she was convicted in the General District Court for Culpeper County, Virginia, of one count of shoplifting, first offense, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 30 days incarceration, with 30 days suspended, and ordered to complete a shoplifters' alternative program within one year and to keep the peace and be of good behavior for one year. She was ordered to pay fines and costs. All fines and costs were paid by August 19, 2015.
- 4. Ms. Divers otherwise meets the requirements for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby

ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Olivia Christine Divers for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a

nurse aide is hereby APPROVED. The Board shall issue Ms. Divers an unrestricted certificate to practice as a

nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

2. Ms. Divers is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Divers shall comply with all laws and regulations governing nurse aide practice in the

Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in

the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public

inspection and copying upon request.
