The Court reviewed and considered the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and made the completed worksheet a part of the record of the case pursuant to the provisions of Code § 19.2-298.01.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court **SENTENCES** the defendant to:

Incarceration in the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of five (5) years for Grand Larceny CR15-171-00, and Incarceration in the Jail of this City for the term of: twelve (12) months for Obtain Money/ETC: False Pretense Larceny < \$200 CR15-171-02 TOTAL SENTENCE IMPOSED: five (5) years and twelve (12) months.

The Court SUSPENDS five (5) years of the Grand Larceny sentence CR15-171-00, and twelve (12) months of the Obtain Money/ ETC: False Pretense Larceny < \$200 sentence CR15-171-02. TOTAL SUSPENSION: five (5) years and twelve (12) months

Sentence suspended upon the following conditions:

- 1. Good behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for a period of two (2) years.
- 2. Supervised Probation. The defendant is placed on Supervised Probation and the defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. Probation shall include the defendant's compliance with any and all programs deemed appropriate by the Probation Officer.

LENGTH OF PROBATION: For an indeterminate period.

PROBATION TO BEGIN: The defendant shall report to the Chesapeake Probation and Parole Office by the close of business today.

The defendant is subject to payment of all or part of the costs of the program or treatment, excluding the costs of the screening and assessment, based upon the defendant's ability to pay.
