CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Jason A. Moore, L.P.N., with his consent as evidenced by his signature below, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Moore's license to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Jason A. Moore, L.P.N., holds license number 0002-048585 issued by the Virginia Board of Nursing.
- 2. An Order was entered by the Virginia Board of Nursing in the matter of Jason A. Moore, L.P.N., on June 18, 1999, placing Mr. Moore on probation subject to certain terms and conditions.
- 3. Mr. Moore violated § 54.1-3007 (2) and (6) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("the Code"), in that during the course of his employment with Genesis Eldercare-Williamsburg Center, on or about September 2000, by his own admission, Mr. Moore used cocaine while on vacation.
- 4. On August 28, 2000, Mr. Moore signed a Participation Contract with the Health Practitioner's Intervention Program ("HPIP"), pursuant to Chapter 25.1 of Title 54.1 of the Code, and 18 VAC 76-10-10, et seq., of the Regulations Governing the Health Practitioner's Intervention Program. On January 2, 2001, Mr. Moore signed a Recovery Monitoring Contract with the HPIP.
- 5. Mr. Moore violated § 54.1-3007 (2) and (6) of the Code, in that:
 - a) Ms. Debbie Miller, assistant to Nancy Hicks, Case Manager with Virginia Monitoring Incorporated ("VMI"), reported that in Spring 2002, Mr. Moore had not

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been reporting for scheduled urine drug screens as required by his Recovery Monitoring Contract.

- b) Ms. Yolanda Carnegie-Chambers, R.N., D.O.N., Mr. Moore's supervisor at Genesis Eldercare-Williamsburg Center, noted a change in Mr. Moore's attitude and appearance on or about May or June 2002, and placed him on leave of absence on or about May 27, 2002.
- cocaine. Positive urine drug screens (for cocaine) were received on June 5th and 21st, 2002. As a result, Mr. Moore was referred by VMI to Sherry Sigafoos, LPC, of Lakeview Psychotherapy, for an evaluation. Based on the results of the evaluation, Mr. Moore was referred to an Intensive Outpatient Program at Riverside New Foundations Program in Newport News, Virginia. Mr. Moore attended the program from on or about July 2002 thru September 2002.
- 6. Mr. Moore returned to work with Genesis Eldercare-Williamsburg Center on or about October 9, 2002 and is currently in compliance with his Recovery Monitoring Contract under terms revised on October 9, 2002.
- 7. On or about April 16, 2002, Mr. Moore petitioned the board to have his probation terminated.

CONSENT

Jason A. Moore, L.P.N., by affixing his signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. Mr. Moore acknowledges that he has been specifically advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

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- 2. Mr. Moore acknowledges that he is fully aware that without his consent, no legal action can be taken against him except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000 A, et seq., of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended;
- 3. Mr. Moore acknowledges that he has the following rights among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, to reasonable notice of said administrative proceeding, to representation by counsel, and the right to present witnesses and evidence on his behalf;
 - 4. Mr. Moore waives all such right to an informal conference;
 - 5. Mr. Moore admits to the above Findings of Fact;
- 6. Mr. Moore consents to the entry of the following Order affecting his practice of practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and with the consent of the licensee, it is hereby ORDERED that the PROBATION placed on Jason A. Moore, L.P.N., to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia, be, and hereby is TERMINATED.

It is furthered ORDERED that Jason A. Moore, L.P.N., remain compliant with all terms and conditions of the HPIP contract entered into August 28, 2000, for the period specified in the Contract.

- 1. Any violation of the terms and conditions stated in this Consent Order shall be reason for revoking the license of Mr. Moore, and an administrative proceeding shall be held to decide whether his license shall be revoked. Mr. Moore shall be noticed to appear before a Committee at such time as the Board is notified that:
 - a) Mr. Moore is not in compliance with the terms and conditions of the HPIP, or has been

terminated from participation in the HPIP, or

- b) There is a pending investigation or unresolved allegations against Mr. Moore involving a violation of law, regulation or any term or condition of probation or this order, or
- c) Mr. Moore has successfully completed the above-referenced period of participation in the HPIP. However, upon receipt of evidence of Mr. Moore's participation in and compliance with the HPIP, the Committee, at its discretion, may waive Mr. Moore's appearance before the Committee, and conduct an administrative review of this matter.

Pursuant to § 2.2-4023 of the Code of Virginia, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public release, inspection and copying upon request.
