RE: Johnnese Jones

ORDER OF SUSPENSION


Section 54.1-104 of the Code of Virginia authorizes the Department of Health Professions to suspend the license, certificate, registration, or any authority issued to any person who submits a check, money draft, or similar instrument for payment of a fee required by statute or regulation which is not honored by the bank or financial institution named thereon. The suspension shall become effective ten (10) days following delivery by certified mail of written notice of the dishonor and the impending suspension to such person's last known address. Suspension under this provision shall be exempt from the Administrative Process Act.

An instrument dated January 20, 2004, was submitted by Johnnese Jones for payment of a certification fee. This instrument was not honored by the financial institution upon which it was drawn. Johnnese Jones was notified of this by letter dated March 30, 2004 and advised of the impending suspension. At least ten days have passed since delivery by certified mail of that letter.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that certificate number 1401090239, issued to Johnnese Jones, is hereby **SUSPENDED**.

This **ORDER** shall be made available for public inspection and notification upon request.
