CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Rebecca Lee Brannock as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Brannock's certificate to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- Rebecca Lee Brannock submitted an application for certificate by examination to 1. practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia on May 5, 2016.
- 2. Ms. Brannock violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3029(4) and 18 VAC 90-50-40(A)(4) in that in 2012, in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Virginia, Ms. Brannock was convicted of conspiracy to distribute a controlled substance. She was sentenced to 42 months incarceration followed by three years supervised probation.
- Ms. Brannock's supervised probation is considered to be in good standing and is 3. scheduled to expire on May 18, 2018. She has paid all costs and fines associated with her convictions.
 - Ms. Brannock otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code § 54.1-3029. 4.

CONSENT

Rebecca Lee Brannock by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; the right to representation by counsel; and the right to cross-examine witnesses against me;
 - I waive all right to an informal conference;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for certification to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Rebecca Lee Brannock is REPRIMANDED.
- 2. The application of Rebecca Lee Brannock for certification to practice massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED. Ms. Brannock shall be issued an unrestricted license.
- 3. Rebecca Lee Brannock shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
