Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered August 3, 2011. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

This case came before the Court for sentencing of the defendant, who appeared in person with her attorney Lawrence D. Gott, the Public Defender. The Commonwealth was represented by Michael D. Defricke.

On 9-22-03 the defendant was found guilty of the following offenses:

The presentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheets. The sentencing guidelines worksheets and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

COMMONWEALTH'S
EXHIBIT

The Court sentences the defendant to:

Incarceration with the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: five (5) years for Grand Larceny (Welfare Fraud). The total sentence imposed is five (5) years.

The Court SUSPENDS five (5) years, upon the following condition(s):

Serve. The defendant shall serve ten (10) months in the Danville City Jail.

Restitution. The defendant shall make restitution in the amount of \$1634.00, which shall be docketed in the Circuit Court Clerk's Office.

Good Behavior. The defendant shall be of good behavior for four (4) years from the defendant's release from probation.

Substance Abuse Screening. The defendant shall complete any substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment as directed by the Department of Corrections. The defendant may be subject to payment of any fees associated with substance abuse treatment or intervention as required by the treatment or intervention program on an ability to pay basis.

Supervised probation. The defendant is placed on probation to commence on her release from incarceration, under the supervision of a Probation Officer for twelve (12) months, or unless sooner released by the Court or by the Probation Officer. The defendant shall comply with all the rules and requirements set by the Probation Officer. The defendant shall seek mental health and job counseling and maintain stable employment.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs of \$800.00.

Right to Appeal. The Court advised the defendant and the defendant's attorney of the defendant's right to appeal this conviction to the Court of Appeals of Virginia.

Credit for time served. The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code 53.1-187.
