CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Brandon Lee Covington, R.M.A., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Mr. Covington's registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Brandon Lee Covington, R.M.A. was issued Registration Number 0031-005940 to practice as a medication aide on June 8, 2012, which is scheduled to expire on November 30, 2016.
- 2. At all times relevant hereto, Brandon Lee Covington, R.M.A., was registered to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 3. Mr. Covington violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(6) in that he is unsafe to practice as a nurse aide due to substance abuse and/or mental and/or physical illness, as evidenced by the following:
- a. On or about December 11, 2015, Mr. Covington was admitted to the inpatient psychiatric program at Centra Health Lynchburg General Hospital, Lynchburg, Virginia, for suicidal ideations and statements, where he was diagnosed with major depressive disorder with a history of alcohol dependence and abuse.
 - b. Mr. Covington has a history of alcohol and illicit drug abuse.
- c. On November 4, 2013, Mr. Covington was convicted in the City of Lynchburg,
 Virginia, General District Court of driving under the influence.
- d. On May 4, 2011, Mr. Covington was convicted in the Appomattox County, Virginia, General District Court of public swearing/intoxication. On August 30, 2011, Mr. Covington was convicted in the City of Lynchburg, Virginia, General District Court of public swearing/intoxication.

4. Mr. Covington violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(2) and 18 VAC 90-60-120(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing the Registration of Medication Aides in that on his February 27, 2012, application for registration as a medication aide, he failed to disclose his two convictions for public swearing/intoxication in the Appomattox County General District Court and in the Lynchburg General District Court.

CONSENT

Brandon Lee Covington, R.M.A., by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

- 1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my registration except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; the right to representation by counsel; and the right to cross-examine witnesses against me;
 - 4. I waive all right to an informal conference;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my right to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The Board accepts the VOLUNTARY SURRENDER for INDEFINITE SUSPENSION of Brandon Lee Covington's registration to practice as a medication aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
 - The registration of Brandon Lee Covington will be recorded as SUSPENDED.

3. Should Brandon Lee Covington seek reinstatement of his registration, an administrative proceeding shall be convened to consider such application. At such time, the burden shall be on Brandon Lee Covington to demonstrate that he is safe and competent to return to nurse aide practice. Brandon Lee Covington shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and/or renewal of the registration prior to issuance of the registration to resume practice.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
