IN RE: ANISSA BURRELL, R.N. REINSTATEMENT

CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Anissa Burrell, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Burrell's application for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Anissa Burrell was issued License No. 0001-138910 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on July 11, 1994. Said license expired on August 31, 2006. Ms. Burrell was issued License No. R131713 to practice professional nursing in the State of Maryland on August 14, 2000. Ms. Burrell's Maryland license expired on August 28, 2004. Ms. Burrell's primary state of residence is Virginia.

2. Ms. Burrell submitted an application for reinstatement of her license which was received by the Board on June 1, 2010.

3. On November 5, 2007, Ms. Burrell was convicted of misdemeanor prescription fraud in the Stafford County, Virginia, Circuit Court. Pursuant to a plea agreement, Ms. Burrell completed two years of probation before her conviction. In exchange for her plea and successful completion of probation, the charge was reduced from a felony to a misdemeanor. Ms. Burrell was sentenced to 12 months of imprisonment, all suspended, and to pay court costs of \$ 296.50.

4. Ms. Burrell submitted to the Board a copy of a receipt dated November 5, 2007, from the Stafford County, Virginia, Circuit Court, which indicates she paid the court costs.

5. From May 9, 2005, to May 13, 2005, Ms. Burrell admitted herself for treatment at Polar Springs Hospital, Petersburg, Virginia, where she was diagnosed with major depressive disorder, not otherwise specified, opioid dependence, and opioid withdrawal. Her prognosis upon discharge was “guarded without adequate treatment.”

6. Ms. Burrell reports that she has not had a relapse since treatment. However, she did not report that she had further treatment.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Finding of Fact No. 3 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
2. Findings of Fact Nos. 3 and 5 constitute a violation of § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code.
3. Based on the above Findings of Fact, Ms. Anissa Burrell is a candidate for the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program (“HPMP”).
4. Ms. Burrell otherwise meets the requirements for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing.

CONSENT

Anissa Burrell, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;

4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for reinstatement of her license to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the application of Anissa Burrell, for reinstatement of her license to practice as a professional nurse is APPROVED contingent upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Ms. Burrell shall enter into the HPMP, pursuant to § 54.1-2515 *et seq.* of the Code and 18 VAC 76-10-10 *et seq.* of the Regulations Governing the HPMP, and shall have proof of entry into the HPMP provided to the Board.
2. Ms. Burrell shall comply with all terms and conditions of the HPMP for the period specified by the HPMP.
3. Any violation of the terms and conditions stated in this Order shall be reason for revoking the license of Ms. Burrell, and an administrative proceeding shall be held to decide whether her license should be revoked. Ms. Burrell shall be noticed to appear before the Board at such time as the Board is notified that:
 - a. Ms. Burrell is not in compliance with the terms and conditions of the HPMP, or has been terminated from participation in the HPMP;
 - b. There is a pending investigation or unresolved allegation against Ms. Burrell involving a violation of law or regulation or any term or condition of this Order; or


c. Ms. Burrell has successfully completed the above-referenced period of participation in the HPMP. However, upon receipt of Ms. Burrell’s participation in and compliance with the HPMP, the Board, at its discretion, may waive Ms. Burrell’s appearance before the Board and conduct an administrative review of this matter.

4. This Order is applicable to Ms. Burrell’s multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia. For the duration of this Order, Ms. Burrell shall not work outside of the Commonwealth of Virginia pursuant to a multistate licensure privilege without the written permission of the Virginia Board of Nursing and the Board of Nursing in the party state where Ms. Burrell wishes to work. Any requests for out of state employment should be directed, in writing, to the Executive Director of the Board.

5. Ms. Burrell shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a professional nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

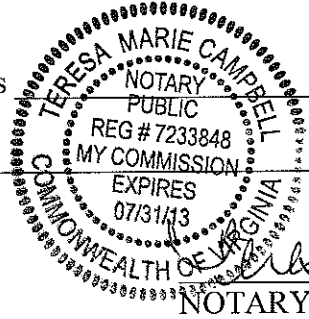
