CONSENT ORDER

JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and ChunHua Wang as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Wang's application for certification by endorsement to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. ChunHua Wang submitted an application for certificate by endorsement to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia on February 7, 2016. Ms. Wang holds License No. MSG009556 to practice a massage therapist in Pennsylvania and License No. 8585 to practice as a massage therapist in Connecticut.
- 2. Ms. Wang violated Virginia Code § 54.1-3007(1) and 18 VAC 90-50-90(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing the Certification of Massage Therapists in that on her application for certification by endorsement to practice as a massage therapist, she answered NO to the questions asking whether she had ever had any disciplinary action taken against her certificate and whether her practice had ever been the subject of an investigation by any licensing or certifying authority. Ms. Wang was cited and fined by the Pennsylvania Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs in June 2015 for holding herself out as a massage therapist or practicing massage therapy while unlicensed.
 - 3. Ms. Wang otherwise meets the requirements of Virginia Code §54.1-3029.

CONSENT

ChunHua Wang by affixing her signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

- 1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my application except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; the right to representation by counsel; and the right to cross-examine witnesses against me;
 - 4. I waive all right to an informal conference;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my application for certification to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Nursing hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of ChunHua Wang for certification to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia is APPROVED.
 - 2 Ms. Wang is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. ChunHua Wang shall comply with all laws and regulations governing the practice of massage therapy in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
