REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION OF AGENCY SUBORDINATE

Jurisdiction and Procedural History

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 2.2-4019 and 54.1-2400(10), Jane Elliott, R.N., Ph.D., serving as

Agency Subordinate of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board"), held an informal conference on

February 16, 2017 in Henrico County, Virginia, to inquire into evidence that Cherlyn Marie Foxx-

Reeves, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing the practice of practical

nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

Ms. Foxx-Reeves did not appear at this proceeding and was not represented by legal counsel.

Upon consideration of the evidence, the Agency Subordinate makes the following Findings of

Fact and Conclusions of Law and recommends that the Board adopt the following Order.

Notice

By letter dated January 23, 2017, the Board sent a Notice of Informal Conference ("Notice") to

Ms. Foxx-Reeves notifying her that an informal conference would be held on February 16, 2017. The

Notice was sent by certified and first class mail to the legal address of record on file with the Board.

The Notice sent by certified mail/UPS was not returned to the Board office. The Notice sent by first

class mail was not returned to the Board office. Accordingly, the Agency Subordinate concluded that

adequate notice was provided to Ms. Foxx-Reeves and the informal conference proceeded in her

absence.

Recommended Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

- 1. Cherlyn Marie Foxx-Reeves, L.P.N., was issued License Number 0002-051981 to practice practical nursing on November 29, 1995, which is scheduled to expire on July 31, 2018. At all times relevant to the findings herein, said license was in full force and effect. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. By Order of the Board entered June 1, 2016 ("Board's Order"), the Board reprimanded Ms. Foxx-Reeves, required she pay a monetary penalty of \$500.00 to the Board within 90 days of the entry of the Board's Order, and required her completion, within 60 days of the entry of the Board's Order, of the following NCSBN courses: Virginia Nurse Practice Act; Professional Accountability and Legal Liability for Nurses; Ethics of Nursing Practice; and Disciplinary Actions: What Every Nurse Should Know. This Order was based on findings that Ms. Reeves had practiced as a professional nurse without a license at Ft. Belvoir Community Hospital, Ft. Belvoir, Virginia, and had falsified employment records with FEFA, Inc., Rockville, Maryland.
- 3. Ms. Foxx-Reeves violated Term Number 2 of the Board's Order in that she has failed to pay the ordered monetary penalty of \$500.00.
- 4. Ms. Foxx-Reeves violated Term Number 3 of the Board's Order in that she has failed to submit verification of completion of the four ordered courses.
- 5. Between August 2016 and October of 2016, Ms. Foxx-Reeves failed to respond to the Department of Health Professions' Compliance Manager.

Recommended Order

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Agency Subordinate recommends that the Board issue an Order as follows:

1. Cherlyn Marie Foxx-Reeves, L.P.N., is REPRIMANDED.

2. The license issued to Cherlyn Marie Foxx-Reeves, L.P.N., to practice practical nursing in

the Commonwealth of Virginia is INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED.

3. The license of Cherlyn Marie Foxx-Reeves, L.P.N., will be recorded as SUSPENDED.

4. This suspension applies to any multistate privilege to practice practical nursing.

5. The license of Cherlyn Marie Foxx-Reeves, L.P.N., shall remain suspended until such

time as she has:

a. Paid the ordered monetary penalty of \$500.00;

b. Provided written proof satisfactory to the Board that she has completed the

following courses: Virginia Nurse Practice Act; Professional Accountability and Legal Liability for

Nurses; Ethics of Nursing Practice; and Disciplinary Actions: What Every Nurse Should Know; and

c. Paid any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and/or renewal of her

practical nursing license prior to the issuance of the license to resume practice.
