ORDER OF SUSPENSION

Section 54.1-104 of the Code of Virginia authorizes the Department of Health Professions to

suspend the license, certificate, registration, or any other authority issued to any person who submits a

check, money draft, or similar instrument for payment of a fee required by statute or regulation which is

not honored by the bank or financial institution named thereon. The suspension shall become effective

ten (10) days following delivery by certified mail of written notice of the dishonor and the impending

suspension to such person's last known address. Suspension under this provision shall be exempt from

the Administrative Process Act.

An instrument dated July 7, 2015, was submitted by Mary Alice Murphy Meaney for payment of

a fee in the amount of \$225.00. The financial institution upon which it was drawn did not honor this

instrument. Mary Alice Murphy Meaney was notified of this by a certified letter dated September 18,

2015, and advised of the impending suspension. At least ten days have passed since that letter was

delivered by certified mail.

It is therefore ORDERED that license number 0001184133, issued to Mary Alice Murphy

Meaney is hereby SUSPENDED.

This ORDER shall be made available for public inspection and notification upon request.
