Dear Ms. Collins:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered May 16, 2016. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Should you wish to petition the Board of Nursing for reinstatement of your license, the application may be obtained at www.dhp.virginia.gov.


ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Lisa R. Hahn, M.P.A., Chief Deputy Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Kathy Renna Collins, L.P.N., was convicted of a felony charge in the Circuit Court for the County of Smyth, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Obtain Drugs by Fraud. A certified copy of the Conviction and Sentencing Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the privilege of Kathy Renna Collins, L.P.N., to renew her license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, suspended.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Kathy Renna Collins, L.P.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Collins seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.



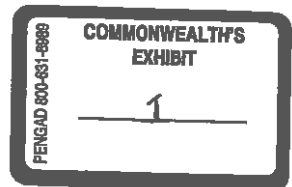

Probation shall include substance abuse counseling an/or testing as prescribed by the Probation Officer.



PROBATION: Supervised
3 Years Commencing: Immediately

Defendant Ordered to complete any substance abuse screening, sex offender assessment, testing and treatment as Directed by the Department of Corrections. The defendant shall be subject payment of any fees associated with substance abuse treatment, sex offender assessment and or intervention and treatment.

Should the defendant become incarcerated at any point during their probation period, the defendant's probation shall be held in abeyance until their release from incarceration.

Defendant directed to submit a blood sample for DNA analysis, if not previously taken.

Special Program. The Defendant shall enter into and successfully complete the following program(s):
Litter Control as directed by the Probation Officer.

Suspension of operator's license:

6 Months

License Surrendered: YES

Court-appointed fee: Court-appointed counsel shall receive a fee in an amount to be determined.

Payment of Costs/Fine/Restitution:

\$50.00 due monthly commencing within 30 days of this date or within 60 days of release from incarceration

Special Conditions: The defendant shall be given credit for time served while awaiting hearing on this matter. The defendant shall follow all recommendations of his probation officer as to drug counseling.

The defendant was allowed to depart.
