ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, Dianne L. Reynolds-Cane, M.D., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Julie J. Cooper, R.N., was convicted of a felony charge in the Circuit Court of the County of Henrico, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs, Third or Subsequent Offense Within Five (5) Years. A certified copy of the Conviction and Sentencing Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Julie J. Cooper, R.N., to practice as a professional nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Julie J. Cooper, R.N., to practice professional nursing by will be recorded as suspended. Should Ms. Cooper seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

CONVICTION AND SENTENCING ORDER

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF HENRICO COUNTY

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA

v.

JULIE J. COOPER

On March 31, 2011, came the defendant, who stands charged with a felony, to-wit: driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs, third or subsequent offense within five (5) years as charged in the indictment in Case No. CR10-4576-00F; and a misdemeanor, to-wit: hit and run, damages totaling \$250.00 or more (Virginia Code Section 46.2-896), as charged in the indictment in Case No. CR10-4853-00M, appeared according to the conditions of her bond, and came also her appointed counsel, David Gullede. The Commonwealth was represented by Stephen Mutnick.

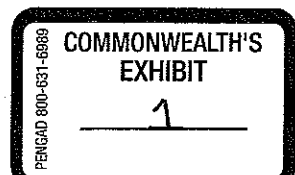
The Court, this day, having heard the evidence in this case on January 20, 2011, finds the defendant guilty of the following offense:

The pre-sentence report was considered and is ordered filed as a part of the record in this case in accordance with the provisions of Code Section 19.2-299.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code Section 19.2-298.01, the Court has considered and reviewed the applicable discretionary sentencing guidelines and the guidelines worksheet. The sentencing guidelines worksheet and the written explanation of any departure from the guidelines are ordered filed as a part of the record in this case.

And it being demanded of the defendant if anything for herself she had or knew to say why judgment should not be pronounced against her according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, the Court sentences the defendant to incarceration with the jail of this County for the term of twelve (12) months, the execution of six (6) months of which sentence is suspended for five (5) years. The Court orders that the conditions of the suspended sentence are that she keep the peace and be of good behavior and that she pay restitution in the amount of \$1,824.82 to David Kenderes to be monitored by the Henrico Community Corrections Program. The Court further Orders that the defendant's operator's license is suspended



indefinitely, that she pay a fine in the amount of \$2,500.00, \$1,500.00 of which is suspended, \$1,000.00 being mandatory, and that she pay the costs of this case in the amount of \$1,165.00.

By operation of law, the defendant's privilege to operate a motor vehicle shall be suspended by the Department of Motor Vehicles effective fifteen days from this date if the fine and costs are not paid pursuant to Virginia Code Section 46.2-395.

The attorney for the Commonwealth moved the Court to nolle prosequi the charge in Case No. CR10-4853-00M, which motion was granted.

The defendant shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Virginia Code Section 53.1-187.

The Court certifies that at all times during this proceeding the defendant was present in person and her attorney was likewise present in person and capably represented the defendant, for which services he is allowed an attorney's fee in the amount of \$445.00.

The Court orders the defendant to report to the Henrico County Jail for the service of her sentence on April 29, 2011, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. with her bond continuing until said date, and thereupon she was allowed to depart.


