

Dear Ms. Brady:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered February 7, 2013. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

**ORDER** 

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I.

Arne W. Owens, Chief Deputy Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and

acted upon evidence that Theresa Lynn Brady, R.N., pled guilty and was found to be guilty of a felony

charge in the Circuit Court of the County of Albemarle, Virginia, to wit: One (1) Count of Attempt

Murder, 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree. A certified copy of the Court Order is attached to this Order and is marked as

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Thereas Lynn Brady, R.N., will be recorded as

suspended and no longer current. Should Ms. Brady seek reinstatement of her license pursuant to

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the

reinstatement and renewal of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order

shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be

made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

The defendant was present with her attorney.

On motion of the Attorney for the Commonwealth and In accordance with a *plea agreement* now filed in this matter, it is Ordered that the above charge be amended to Attempt Murder, 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree.

The accused was arraigned and after private consultation with and being advised by her said counsel and in accordance with a plea agreement now filed in this case, pleaded guilty to the Indictment, which plea was tendered by the accused in person, and the Court, having made inquiry and being of the opinion that the accused fully understood the nature and effect of her plea and of the penalties that may be imposed upon her conviction and of the waiver of trial by jury and



of appeal, and finding that her plea was voluntarily and intelligently made, proceeded to hear and determine the case and having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, the Court finds the defendant GUILTY as charged in the Indictment.

The Court, before fixing punishment or imposing sentence, directs the Probation Officer of this Court to thoroughly investigate and report to the Court as provided by law on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.

The defendant is ORDERED to cooperate fully and promptly in providing information and permitting the withdrawal of blood samples as required by law.

The Court certifies that at all times during the trial of this case the defendant was personally present with her attorney.

The defendant was remanded to jail.
