ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and issues this Order affecting the license of Michael J. Shipman, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Michael J. Shipman, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-213592 to practice as a professional nurse by the Virginia Board of Nursing on July 2, 2008. Said license expired on July 31, 2014. Mr. Shipman holds current licenses in Illinois and Indiana. His primary state of residence is Washington.
2. By Order of the Board entered on September 24, 2013, the Board placed Mr. Shipman on indefinite probation with terms and conditions to include complying with all terms and conditions of the Consent Order of the Illinois Board of Nursing entered April 25, 2012.
3. By Consent Order entered October 2, 2015, the Illinois Board removed Mr. Shipman’s probationary status and restored his license to active, unencumbered status.
4. Mr. Shipman submitted a petition for release from probation on January 19, 2016.
5. Mr. Shipman has complied with all terms and conditions of probation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. This matter is properly before the Board.
