#### <u>ORDER</u>

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4019, 2.2-4021, and 54.1-2400(10) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a Special Conference Committee ("Committee") of the Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") met on February 9, 2016, in Henrico County, Virginia, to receive and act upon the application of Courtney D. Harvey for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Harvey may have violated certain laws governing nurse aide practice. Ms. Harvey was present and was not represented by legal counsel.

Upon consideration of the evidence, the Committee adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Courtney D. Harvey was issued Certificate No. 1401-142243 to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia on January 20, 2011. Said certificate expired on January 31, 2013.
- 2. By letter dated January 7, 2016, the Board of Nursing sent a Notice of Informal Conference ("Notice") to Ms. Harvey notifying her that an informal conference would be held on February 9, 2016. The Notice was sent by certified and first class mail to 2837 Turnpike Road, Portsmouth, Virginia 23707, the address of record on file with the Board of Nursing.
- 3. Ms. Harvey submitted an application for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide which was received by the Board on December 8, 2015.

- 4. On October 4, 2012, in the General District Court of Virginia Beach, Virginia, Ms. Harvey was convicted of two counts of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
- 5. Ms. Harvey was sentenced to 365 days in jail, with 360 days suspended, and ordered to pay court costs totaling \$272.50, which were paid on March 21, 2013.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 4 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code.
- 2. The Committee concludes that Courtney D. Harvey has demonstrated satisfactory evidence that she is prepared to resume practice in a safe and competent manner.

### <u>ORDER</u>

On the basis of the foregoing, the Committee hereby ORDERS the following:

- 1. Certificate No. 1401-142243 of Courtney D. Harvey to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia is REINSTATED.
  - 2. Ms. Harvey is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Harvey shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400(10) of the Code, Ms. Harvey may, not later than 5:00 p.m., on March 29, 2016, notify Jay P. Douglas, M.S.M., R.N., C.S.A.C., F.R.E., Executive Director, Board of Nursing, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in writing that she desires a formal administrative

hearing before the Board. Upon the filing with the Executive Director of a request for the hearing, this Order shall be vacated.
