Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered April 29, 2015. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your license to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your license, and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

Before pronouncing the sentence, the Court inquired if the defendant desired to make a statement and if the defendant desired to advance any reason why judgment should not be pronounced.

The Court accepted the Plea Agreement and SENTENCES the defendant to:

Incarceration in the Virginia Department of Corrections for the term of: 1 year on each charge of Obtain Food Stamps Under False Pretense (5 cts.). The total sentence imposed is 5 years.

The Court SUSPENDS the execution of all of the above sentence on the following condition(s):

- 1. Good Behavior. The defendant shall remain of uniform good behavior during incarceration and for 5 years thereafter.
- 2. Other. The defendant shall be permanently disqualified from the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP), in the State of Virginia and consents to her information being placed in the SNAP national database reflecting her permanent disqualification.
- 3. Other. The defendant shall be permanently disqualified from the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), in the State of Virginia.

Restitution. The defendant shall pay restitution in the amount of \$16,496.00 directly to the Virginia Beach Department of Human Resources.

Credit for time served. The defendant sentenced to a term of confinement in a correctional facility shall be given credit for time spent in confinement while awaiting trial pursuant to Code § 53.1-187.

Costs. The defendant shall pay costs pursuant to statute.
