NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Kelly E. Cramer, R.N., who holds License No. 0001-120556 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, which expires on August 31, 2017, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on January 27, 2016, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Cramer will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Cramer has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Cramer desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Cramer may have violated certain laws governing nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Kelly E. Cramer, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that on October 31, 2014, Ms. Cramer was admitted to CJW Medical Center, Tucker Pavilion, Richmond, Virginia, with a provisional diagnosis of mood disorder and bipolar disorder. Further, by her own admission, Ms. Cramer has been diagnosed with lupus and she has a history of alcohol abuse. Ms. Cramer has not consistently attended the recommended therapy and substance abuse treatment.
