NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Eddie Moussa, L.P.N., who holds License No. 0002-075704 which expires on August 31, 2012, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on May 17, 2012 at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Mr. Moussa will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Mr. Moussa has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on his behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Mr. Moussa desires any witnesses to appear on his behalf, he must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Mr. Moussa may have violated certain laws governing licensed practical nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Eddie Moussa, L.P.N., may have violated §54.1-3007(5) and (8) of the Code a in that between March, 2009, and March 16, 2011, during the course of his employment with Vitas Innovative Hospice Care, Vienna, Virginia, Mr. Moussa stole credit cards and checks from Patient A, Patient B, Patient C and Patient D.
