CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Jessica Prioleau, L.P.N., as evidenced by 1er signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Prioleau's license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Jessica Prioleau, L.P.N. was issued License No. 0002-071688 to practice practic: I nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on July 18, 2005. Said license is set to expire on January 31, 2016. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
- 2. Between June 2011 and May 2013, during the course of her employment with Jemsek Specialty Clinic, Washington, D.C., Ms. Prioleau practiced practical nursing and held hers if out as a licensed practical nurse without holding a license or privilege to practice nursing in the District c 'Columbia. Her job title was "L.P.N., Triage," and her job description included the following: "assess paties t needs and identifying potential problems; act as the patient's advocate through timely collaboration with ther health care providers and personnel; and provide accurate and timely follow-up to physician and other health care personnel involved with the patient's care; including accurate and timely documentation in the patient record."
- 3. Ms. Prioleau submitted an application for licensure to practice practical nursing in the District of Columbia on May 28, 2013.

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4. In an Order entered March 12, 2014, the District of Columbia Board of Nursi ig denied Ms. Prioleau's application for licensure. The denial was based on findings that Ms. Prioleau had violated District of Columbia law by engaging in the practice of nursing without a license for a period of 23 mor ths.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of §§ 54.1-3007(3) and 54.1-3001 (A)(2) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - Finding of Fact No. 4 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(7) of the Code.

CONSENT

Jessica Prioleau, L.P.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken again t her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code:
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, he right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practical nursing in Virginia.

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ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- Jessica Prioleau, L.P.N. is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 2. Ms. Prioleau shall pay a MONETARY PENALTY of \$500.00 to the Board witi in 90 days of the entry of this Order.
- 3. Ms. Prioleau shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Boar of Nursing Regulations.
- 4. Any violation of the terms and conditions of this Order or of any law or regulation affecting the practice of nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia shall constitute grounds for the suspension of the license of Ms. Prioleau and an administrative proceeding shall be convened to determine whether such license shall be suspended or revoked.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
