NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended

("Code"), George Redifer, C.M.T., who holds Certificate No. 0019-011093 to practice as a massage therapist

in Virginia which expires on November 30, 2015, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing

will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on November 18,

2015, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter

Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Mr. Redifer will be afforded

the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Mr. Redifer has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on his behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Mr. Redifer desires any

witnesses to appear on his behalf, he must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Mr. Redifer may have violated certain laws

and regulations governing massage therapy practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of

Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that George Redifer, C.M.T., may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5); and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-50-90(2)(d) and (i) of the Regulations Governing the Certification of Massage

Therapists, as referenced in Section XIV of the Code of Ethics of the National Certification Board for

Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork, in that during the course of his employment with Knuckles N Knots

Day Spa, Virginia Beach, Virginia, on or about October 22, 2014, he engaged in a sexual act with a coworker while providing the co-worker with a massage. Further, he failed to document the massage.
