AMENDED NOTICE OF HEARING

by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Allison has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Allison desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Allison may have violated certain laws governing practical nursing practice in Virginia and certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on December 18, 2012 ("Board's Order"), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

## STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

- 1. Ms. Allison may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that she may be unsafe to practice due to her use of narcotic medications.
- 2. Ms. Allison may be in violation of Term No. 1 of the Board's Order, which required her to enter into and comply with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that Ms. Allison was dismissed from the HPMP for non-compliance with the HPMP contract on May 16, 2014.
