NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Guo Hua Cui, C.M.T., who holds Certificate No. 0019-012907 to practice massage therapy in Virginia, which expires on December 31, 2015, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on November 18, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Cui will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Cui has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Cui desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Guo Hua Cui, C.M.T., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing massage therapy practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.


STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

1. Guo Hua Cui, C.M.T., may not meet the requirements of § 54.1-3029(3) of the Code because by letter dated December 29, 2014, the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards (FSMTB) invalidated her test score, which she used on her April 24, 2014 application for certification to practice massage therapy in Virginia.

2. Ms. Cui may have violated § 54.1-3007(1), (2) and (5) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-50-90(1)(b) and (2)(i) of the Regulations Governing the Certification of Massage Therapists, as further defined by Section II of the National Certification Board for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork Code of Ethics, in that she falsified the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Examination (MBLEx) Application dated November 27, 2012, by stating that she had attended the Bodyconcepts Wellness Institute when she had not actually done so.
