NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended

("Code"), Raven D. Hundley, C.N.A., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on March 30,

2015, held Certificate No. 1401-163618 to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia, is hereby given notice that

formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing

will be held on November 16, 2015, at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions,

Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time

Ms. Hundley will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Hundley has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Hundley desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Raven D. Hundley, C.N.A., may have

violated certain laws governing nurse aide practice in Virginia and certain terms and conditions imposed on

her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on March 30, 2015, as more fully set forth in the Statement

of Particulars below.

## STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that:

- 1. Raven D. Hundley, C.N.A., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 4(a) of the Order entered March 30, 2015, which required Ms. Hundley to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that on or about July 17, 2015, Ms. Hundley was dismissed from the HPMP due to noncompliance. Specifically, Ms. Hundley failed to remain in contact with her HPMP case manager and failed to notify the HPMP of her entry into the Pathways Treatment Center aftercare program.
- 2. Ms. Hundley may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code in that she may be unsafe to practice as a nurse aide as evidenced by her hospitalizations for substance abuse and mental health treatment on or about May 25, July 20, and August 13, 2015.
