CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) and Julette Y. Lane, L.P.N., as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Lane’s license to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Julette Y. Lane, L.P.N., was issued License No. 0002-028875 to practice practical nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on November 26, 1980. Said license expired on December 31, 2012. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. Ms. Lane submitted an application for reinstatement of her license which was received by the Board on August 24, 2015.
3. On February 19, 1974, in the General District Court of the City of Richmond, Virginia, Ms. Lane was convicted of misdemeanor possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. On February 16, 1977, in the General District Court of Henrico County, Virginia, Ms. Lane was convicted of misdemeanor possession of marijuana.
4. On her initial application for licensure dated August 11, 1980, Ms. Lane failed to disclose the above-referenced convictions.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Finding of Fact No. 4 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(1) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(1)(b) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing [formerly § 54-367.32 of the Code and Section VIII, 8.1(a) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing].

CONSENT

Julette Y. Lane, L.P.N., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her right to practice practical nursing in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The license of Julette Y. Lane, L.P.N., is REINSTATED without restriction.

2. Ms. Lane is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Lane shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a practical nurse commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.

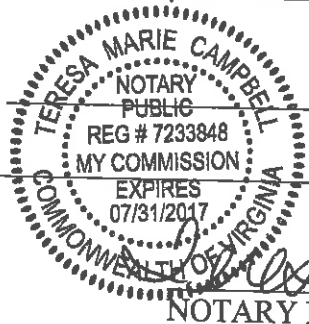
