CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Donna D. Coletraine, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Coletraine's application for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Donna D. Coletraine was issued Certificate No. 1401-027711 to practice as a nurse aide by the Virginia Board of Nursing on December 14, 1991. Said certificate expired on December 31, 2009.
2. Ms. Coletraine submitted an application for the reinstatement of her certificate which was received by the Board on June 16, 2015.
3. On March 19, 2012, Ms. Coletraine was convicted in the United States District Court for the Western District of Virginia, of one count of Conspiracy to Make, Utter and Possess Counterfeit Securities and one count of Making, Uttering and Possessing Counterfeit Securities, both felonies. She was sentenced to five years probation. She was also ordered to pay restitution, fines and costs.
4. Ms. Coletraine is currently making payments on her restitution, fines and court costs.
5. Ms. Coletraine has not performed nursing related activities for compensation in over two years.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that:

1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

2. Pursuant to Finding of Fact No. 5 and 18 VAC 90-25-80(A)(4) of the Regulations Governing Certified Nurse Aides, Ms. Coletraine is required to retake the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program (“NNAAP”) examination.

3. Ms. Coletraine otherwise meets the requirements for reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide.

CONSENT

Donna D. Coletraine, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) *et seq.* of the Code;
3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
6. She consents to the entry of the following Consent Order affecting her application for the reinstatement of her certificate to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

ORDER


WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Consent Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Donna D. Coletraine for reinstatement of her certification to practice as a nurse aide is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the NNAAP examination, the Board shall issue Ms. Coletraine an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
2. Ms. Coletraine is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Coletraine shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 *et seq.* of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
