The Board alleges that Christy Gatlin, L.P.N., may have violated Term No. 2(e) of the 2013 Order and Term No. 2(f) of the 2012 Order, both of which required her to submit self-reports within 60 days of the entry of each Order and quarterly thereafter. She failed to submit self-reports for the quarters ending March 31, 2013; September 30, 2013; December 31, 2013; September 30, 2014; and December 31, 2014.
