NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended

("Code"), Lora C. Schwarz, R.N., who holds License No. 0001-111738 to practice professional nursing in

Virginia, which expires on July 31, 2017, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be

held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing ("Board"). The hearing will be held on September

17, 2015, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter

Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Schwarz will be

afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Schwarz has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Schwarz desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Schwarz may have violated certain

laws and regulations governing professional nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the

Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Ms. Schwarz may have violated § 54.1-3007(2), (5) and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(a) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing in that on or about February 15, 2014, during the course of her employment with West Neck Intermediate Care Facility, Virginia Beach, Virginia, Ms. Schwarz directed an on-duty nurse to insert a Foley catheter into a resident without a physician's order.
