**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Erin N. Everitt, R.N., who, prior to its summary suspension by the Board of Nursing on May 12, 2015, held License No. 0001-208301, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on September 14, 2015, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Everitt will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Everitt has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Everitt desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Everitt may have violated certain laws governing the practice of nursing and certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on January 27, 2015, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Ms. Everitt may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 4 of the Board's Order entered January 27, 2015 ("Board's Order"), which stayed the suspension of her license contingent on her re-entry into and compliance with the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that she resigned from the HPMP effective April 27, 2015. Further, Ms. Everitt failed to comply with the terms of the HPMP in that she failed to complete the substance abuse and mental health assessment required by the HPMP and failed to respond to HPMP communications after January 29, 2015.
