ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing (“Board”) issues the following Order affecting the license of Tammy L. Moore, R.N., to practice professional nursing in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Tammy L. Moore, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-224880 to practice professional nursing by the Virginia Board of Nursing on June 16, 2010. Said license is set to expire on November 30, 2016. Ms. Moore’s primary state of residence is West Virginia.
2. By Order of the Board of Nursing entered October 3, 2014 (“Board’s Order”), Ms. Moore was placed on probation under certain terms and conditions. The Board took action against Ms. Moore’s license as a result of her West Virginia nursing license being placed on stayed suspension under certain terms and conditions for not less than one year. Once Ms. Moore was released from the terms and conditions of the West Virginia Order, she could request that the Board lift the probation on her Virginia license.
3. On December 10, 2014, Ms. Moore requested to be released from the terms of her probation.
4. Ms. Moore was released from the terms of her probation with the West Virginia Board of Nursing on June 12, 2015.
5. On July 13, 2015, Ms. Moore’s compliance case manager notified the Board that Ms. Moore had completed her probationary period and is substantially compliant with the terms of the Board Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The Board finds that Tammy L. Moore has complied with the terms and conditions of the Board's Order.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS that Tammy L. Moore's probation be TERMINATED and that she be issued a license to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia marked "Valid in Virginia only."

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
