ORDER OF SUMMARY SUSPENSION

The purpose of the meeting was to receive and act upon certain information indicating that Brandy Oakes, L.P.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations relating to the practice of practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia, as more fully set forth in the attached "NOTICE OF HEARING and STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS," which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

WHEREUPON, pursuant to its authority under §54.1-2408.1(A) of the Code, the Board concludes that a substantial danger to public health or safety warrants this action and ORDERS that the license of Brandy Oakes, L.P.N., License No. 0002-066320, to practice PRACTICAL NURSING in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby SUSPENDED. It is further ORDERED that a hearing be convened forthwith to receive and act upon evidence in this case and that the Executive Director of the Board shall be authorized to execute this Order and all other documents, notices and orders on behalf of the Board necessary to bring this matter to a hearing.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of Brandy Oakes, L.P.N., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current.

This Order shall be applicable to Ms. Oakes' multistate licensure privilege, if any, to practice practical nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
