Dear Ms. Lewis:

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), you are hereby given notice that your license to practice as a registered professional nurse, and the privilege to renew your license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia have been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered August 24, 2015. You are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 54.1-2409.1 of the Code, any person who practices a profession or occupation after having their license or certificate to do so suspended shall be guilty of a felony. Please return your licenses to Jay P. Douglas, Executive Director of the Board of Nursing, at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

Section 54.1-2409 of the Code further provides that you may apply to the Board of Nursing ("Board") for reinstatement of your licenses and shall be entitled to a hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of sixty days from the receipt of such reinstatement application. You have the following rights, among others: to be represented by legal counsel, to have witnesses subpoenaed on your behalf, to present documentary evidence and to cross-examine adverse witnesses. The reinstatement of your licenses shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members present of the Board of Nursing.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 54.1-2409 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, ("Code"), I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that Tonya Yvette Compton Lewis, R.N., L.P.N., was convicted of felony charges in the Circuit Court of Washington County, Virginia, to wit:

1. One (1) Count of Possess Schedule I/II; and
2. Three (3) Counts of Prescription Fraud.

A certified copy of the First Offender Revocation Order is attached to this Order and is marked as Commonwealth's Exhibit No. 1.

WHEREFORE, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, it is hereby ORDERED that the licenses of Tonya Yvette Compton Lewis, R.N., L.P.N., to practice as a registered professional nurse, and her privilege to renew her license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the Commonwealth of Virginia be, and hereby are, SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the licenses of Tonya Yvette Compton Lewis, R.N., L.P.N., will be recorded as suspended. Should Ms. Lewis seek reinstatement of her licenses pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement and renewal of her licenses prior to issuance of her licenses to resume practice.

Pursuant to Sections 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order

shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

The defendant was heretofore granted first offender status on August 25, 2011 on the above stated charges and was placed on probation as a First Offender for a period of three (3) years to begin that date.

The defendant was brought before the Court on this day to show cause why his/her suspension/probation should not be revoked for the following offense(s):

The Court, having heard statements from the Attorney for the Commonwealth and statements from the defendant, finds the defendant guilty of violating the terms of his probation and revokes the defendant's first offender status.

The Court sentences the defendant to five (5) years on each count. Further, the Court suspends the entire sentence and places the defendant on probation for a period of two (2) years to begin this date. Further, the defendant was remanded to jail and directed to allow her DNA taken.

DRUG SCREENING, ASSESSMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM. The defendant shall complete any substance abuse screening, assessment, testing and treatment as directed by the Department of Corrections. The defendant is subject to payment of any fees associated with substance abuse treatment or intervention as required by the treatment or intervention program on an ability to pay basis.

COSTS. The defendant will pay costs on a schedule previously established.

The defendant was remanded to custody.
