CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and McKinla S. Reed, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Reed's application for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. By application received June 19, 2015, McKinla S. Reed applied for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
 - 2. Ms. Reed has been convicted of the following crimes:
- a. On February 1, 2008, she was convicted in the General District Court of the City of Hampton, Virginia, of one count of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to six months incarceration with all time suspended, placed on two years unsupervised probation, and ordered to pay fines and court costs. All costs and fines were paid on March 12, 2008.
- b. On June 20, 2008, she was convicted in the General District Court for the City of Newport News, Virginia, of one count of giving a false report to a police officer with the intent to mislead, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 30 days incarceration with all time suspended, and ordered to pay fines and costs. All fines and costs were paid on September 15, 2008.
- c. On July 14, 2008, she was convicted in the General District Court of the City of Hampton, Virginia, of one count of shoplifting, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 12 months incarceration with 9 months suspended, placed on two years unsupervised probation, and ordered to pay fines and court costs. All costs and fines were paid on October 14, 2008.

d. On February 12, 2013, she was convicted in the Circuit Court for the City of Newport News, Virginia, of one count of felony petit larceny, third or subsequent offense. She was sentenced to 5 years incarceration with 4 years and 11 months suspended. She was placed on supervised probation for one year, and then was ordered to keep the peace and be of good behavior for five years and to pay fines and costs. All fines and costs were paid on September 9, 2013, and she was released from probation on February 2, 2014.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - 2. Ms. Reed otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

CONSENT

McKinla S. Reed, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;

6. She consents to the entry of the following Consent Order affecting her application for certification to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Consent Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of McKinla S. Reed for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide is hereby APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program examination, the Board shall issue Ms. Reed an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
 - 2. Ms. Reed is hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Ms. Reed shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.
