**NOTICE OF HEARING**

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), Linda A. Wilson, R.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on July 23, 2015, held License No. 0001-111663 to practice professional nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing will be held on November 16, 2015, at 1:00 p.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms. Wilson will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.


At the hearing, Ms. Wilson has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Wilson desires any witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Ms. Wilson may have violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on October 3, 2014 (“Board’s Order”), as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

**STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS**

The Board alleges that Linda A. Wilson, R.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended (“Code”), and Term No. 5(a) of the Board’s Order, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners’ Monitoring Program (“HPMP”) for the period specified by the HPMP in that on or about July 17, 2015, Ms. Wilson was dismissed from the HPMP for noncompliance, including failure to enter and complete treatment as recommended and failure to comply with the toxicology screening program.
