ORDER

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 54.1-110 and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), a formal administrative hearing was held before a panel of the Board of Nursing ("Board") on July 15, 2015, in Henrico County, Virginia, to inquire into evidence that Jamie N. Stiltner, R.N., may have violated certain laws and regulations governing nursing practice in Virginia. The case was presented by Amanda E. M. Blount, Adjudication Specialist, Administrative Proceedings. Charis A. Mitchell, Assistant Attorney General, was present as legal counsel for the Board. Ms. Stiltner was not present and was not represented by legal counsel. The proceedings were recorded by a certified court reporter.

Upon consideration of the evidence presented, the Board adopted the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jamie N. Stiltner, R.N., was issued License No. 0001-177688 to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on February 13, 2002. Said license expires on September 30, 2015. Her primary state of residence is Virginia.
2. Based on the representations of Amanda E. M. Blount, Adjudication Specialist, and Commonwealth's Exhibit #1, the Notice of Formal Hearing and Statement of Particulars and Affidavit of Mailing dated June 16, 2015, and the Allegation Summary Worksheet, the presiding officer ruled that adequate notice was provided to Ms. Stiltner and the hearing proceeded in her absence.
3. During the course of her employment with Dickenson Community Hospital, Clintwood, Virginia:

a. On September 1, 2014, Ms. Stiltner was observed sleeping in a patient's room while assigned to care for the patient in the emergency department.

b. On November 3-4, 2014, during the 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. shift, Ms. Stiltner was noted to be erratic and loud at the beginning of her shift, and was later observed slumped over in her chair, unaware of events occurring around her, and difficult to arouse. She was subsequently given a urine drug screen, which was positive for oxycodone and oxymorphone, for which she did not have valid prescriptions.

4. On December 12, 2014, at the request of a Virginia Department of Health Professions investigator, Ms. Stiltner submitted to a urine drug screen, which was positive for hydromorphone, for which she did not have a valid prescription.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that:

1. Findings of Fact Nos. 3(a) and 3(b) constitute violations of § 54.1-3007(2), (5), (6), and (8) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) and (f) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Nursing ("Regulations").

2. Finding of Fact No. 4 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(2) and (6) of the Code and 18 VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) of the Regulations.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. License No. 0001-177688 issued to Jamie N. Stiltner, R.N., to practice professional nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED for a period of not less than one year.


2. The license will be recorded as SUSPENDED and no longer current. Should Ms. Stiltner seek reinstatement of her license consistent with this Order, she shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of her license prior to issuance of her license to resume practice.

3. At such time as Ms. Stiltner shall petition the Board for reinstatement of her license, an administrative proceeding will be convened to determine whether she is able to return to the safe and competent practice of professional nursing.

4. This Order shall be applicable to Ms. Stiltner's multistate licensure privileges, if any, to practice professional nursing.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.
