NOTICE OF HEARING

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4020, 2.2-4024(F), and 54.1-2400(11) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended

("Code"), Carroll J. Roberts, L.P.N., who, prior to its suspension by the Board of Nursing on February 5,

2015, held License No. 0002-052965 to practice practical nursing in Virginia, is hereby given notice that a

formal administrative hearing will be held in the presence of a panel of the Board of Nursing. The hearing

will be held on June 15, 2015, at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, Board of

Nursing, Perimeter Center, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 201, Henrico, Virginia 23233, at which time Ms.

Roberts will be afforded the opportunity to be heard in person or by counsel.

At the hearing, Ms. Roberts has the following rights, among others: the right to representation by

counsel; the right to have witnesses subpoenaed and to present witnesses on her behalf; the right to present

documentary evidence; and the right to cross-examine adverse witnesses. If Ms. Roberts desires any

witnesses to appear on her behalf, she must notify the Director of Administrative Proceedings, Department of

Health Professions, 9960 Mayland Drive, Suite 300, Henrico, Virginia 23233, in accordance with the

Instructions for Requesting Subpoenas.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into evidence that Carroll J. Roberts, L.P.N., may have

violated certain terms and conditions imposed on her as set forth in the Order of the Board entered on June

17, 2014, and to inquire into evidence that Ms. Roberts may have violated certain laws governing practical

nursing practice in Virginia, as more fully set forth in the Statement of Particulars below.

STATEMENT OF PARTICULARS

The Board alleges that Carroll J. Roberts, L.P.N., may have violated § 54.1-3007(6) of the Code and Term No. 5 of the Order entered June 17, 2014, which required her to comply with all terms and conditions of the Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"), in that on or about January 26, 2015, Ms. Roberts was dismissed from the HPMP due to continued use of alcohol and failure to enter and complete treatment as recommended. On or about October 8 and 13, 2014, and November 25, 2014, Ms. Roberts tested positive for alcohol and she admitted to drinking alcoholic beverages.
