CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Onella L. Taitt, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Taitt's application for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. By application received August 8, 2014, Onella L. Taitt applied for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 2. On December 13, 2012, Ms. Taitt was convicted in the General District Court of the City of Chesapeake, Virginia, of one count of petit larceny, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was ordered to pay \$82.00 in court costs. All costs were paid.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - 2. Ms. Taitt otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3023 of the Code.

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;

She consents to the entry of the following Consent Order affecting her application for certification to

practice as a nurse aide in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this

Consent Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The application of Onella L. Taitt for certification by examination to practice as a nurse aide is hereby

APPROVED. Upon successful completion of the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program examination, the Board

shall issue Ms. Taitt an unrestricted certificate to practice as a nurse aide in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

2. Ms. Taitt is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Taitt shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a nurse aide commensurate with the

requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in

the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection

or copying upon request.
