

CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("The Board") and Deborah Smith Guill, R. N., as evidenced by their signatures affixed below, agree to enter into this Consent Order affecting the license of Ms. Guill to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board adopts the following findings of fact in this matter:

- 1. Deborah Smith Guill, R.N., was issued license number 0001-159136 by the Board to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia on June 17, 1998.
- 2 On February 19, 2009, Ms. Guill entered into a Consent Order with the North Carolina Board of Nursing ("North Carolina Board") surrendering her privilege to practice professional nursing in North Carolina for one year. This action was based on Ms. Guill having reported to work at Women's Hospital of Greensboro, North Carolina, on December 30, 2008, with slurred speech and stumbling and later testing positive for marijuana. Based upon this action in North Carolina, on December 10, 2009, the Virginia Board entered an Order taking no action against Ms. Guill contingent upon her compliance with certain terms and conditions.
- 3. By Consent Order entered January 25, 2011, the Virginia Board reprimanded Ms. Guill and Indefinitely Suspended her license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia, with said suspension stayed upon proof of entry into and compliance with the

Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program ("HPMP"). This action was based on Ms. Guill's violation of Term No. 2 of the December 10, 2009, Order, § 54.1-3007(2), (5), (6) and (8) of the Code and 18VAC 90-20-300(A)(2)(c) and (e) of the Board of Nursing Regulations in that between March, 2009 and April, 2010, Ms. Guill diverted various Schedule II and IV medications from patient supplies for her personal and unauthorized use. Ms. Guill entered the Virginia HPMP on December 24, 2010, and is currently in compliance.

- 4. By Default and Decision Order effective on November 15, 2011, the State of California Board of Registered Nursing ("California Board") accepted the surrender of the Registered Nurse License issued to Deborah Smith Guill, R.N. Said surrender to have the same effect as revocation. This action was based on the Virginia Board's Order entered on December 10, 2009, the subsequent Order entered on January 25, 2011, and on the North Carolina Board's Consent Order entered on February 19, 2009.
- 5. By Order entered January 25, 2012, the Director of the Department of Health Professions mandatorily suspended Ms. Guill's license pursuant to Section 54.1-2409 of the Code due to the action of the California Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter of the reinstatement of Ms. Guill's license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia is properly before the Board.

CONSENT

- I have been advised specifically to seek the advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me, except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000.A et seq. of the Code of Virginia;
 - 3. I have the following rights, among others:
 - a. the right to a formal administrative hearing before the Board;
 - the right to appear in person or by counsel, or other qualified
 representative before the agency; and
 - c. the right to cross-examine witnesses against me.
 - 4. I waive all rights to a formal hearing;
 - 5. I admit the truth of the above Findings of Fact; and
- I consent to the following Order affecting my license to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

<u>ORDER</u>

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and with the consent of the licensee, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of Deborah Smith Guill, R.N., to practice nursing in the Commonwealth of Virginia, be, and hereby is, REINSTATED.

Further License No. 0001-159136 of Deborah S. Guill, R.N., is INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED. The license will be recorded as suspended and no longer current.

This suspension shall be STAYED upon Ms. Guill's continued compliance with the HPMP pursuant to Chapter 25.1 of Title 54.1 of the Code and 18 VAC 76-10-10 et seq. of the

Regulations Governing the HPMP and pursuant to the terms and conditions placed on her as referenced in the Board's Order of January 25, 2011.

Ms. Guill shall maintain a course of conduct in her practice of nursing commensurate with the requirements of Title 54.1, Chapter 29 of the Code and all laws of the Commonwealth.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
