CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Nursing ("Board") and Megan N. Stinnett, as evidenced by her signature hereto, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Ms. Stinnett's application for certification by examination to practice as a massage therapist in Virginia.

The Board adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- By application received April 17, 2015, Megan N. Stinnett applied for certification by examination to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- 2. On November 6, 2013, Ms. Stinnett was convicted in the General District Court for the City of Roanoke, Virginia, of one count of shoplifting, a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. She was sentenced to 60 days incarceration, with all time suspended, and she was ordered to pay \$216.00 in court costs. Ms. Stinnett paid all costs.
- 3. On March 21, 2015, Ms. Stinnett passed the Massage & Bodywork Licensing Examination ("MBLEx").

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board concludes that:

- 1. Finding of Fact No. 2 constitutes a violation of § 54.1-3007(4) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").
 - 2. Ms. Stinnett otherwise meets the requirements of § 54.1-3029 of the Code.

CONSENT

Megan N. Stinnett, by affixing her signature hereon, agrees to the following:

- 1. She has been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
- 2. She acknowledges that without her consent, no legal action can be taken against her except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000(A) et seq. of the Code;
- 3. She acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact finding conference before the Board, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to representation by counsel, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;
 - 4. She waives all such right to an informal conference;
- 5. She admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives her right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board;
- 6. She consents to the entry of the following Order affecting her application for certification to practice as a massage therapist in Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Virginia Board of Nursing, effective upon entry of this Order, and in lieu of further proceedings, hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1. The application of Megan N. Stinnett for certification by examination to practice as a massage therapist is hereby APPROVED. Ms. Stinnett shall be issued an unrestricted certification to practice as a massage therapist in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
 - 2. Megan N. Stinnett is hereby REPRIMANDED.

3. Ms. Stinnett shall maintain a course of conduct in her capacity as a massage therapist commensurate with the requirements of § 54.1-3000 et seq. of the Code and the Board of Nursing Regulations.

Pursuant to §§ 2.2-4023 and 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying upon request.


